Various issues pertaining to the South China Sea dispute were discussed in the context of regional peace and stability. The discussion also dwelt on ASEAN's role in resolving the dispute and its spillover effect on ASEAN solidarity.

There was a consensus among the participants that the territorial and maritime claims in the region should be resolved under the ambit of international law, maintaining freedom of navigation for the larger world.
