The Indian Council of World Affairs (ICWA), in collaboration with the Embassy of the Republic of Poland in New Delhi, is organizing a panel discussion on the book entitled, “India-Poland Relations in the 21st Century: Vistas for Future Cooperation” on 24 June 2014 at Sapru House, New Delhi. The book is edited by Dr. Vijay Sakhuja, Dr. Dinoj K. Upadhyay and Mr. Patryk Kugiel and is jointly published by the ICWA and the Polish Institute of International Affairs (PISM), Warsaw.
