The Indian Council of World Affairs (ICWA), an institution of national importance incorporated under the ICWA Act, 2001, invites applications ([Download Form](#)) for positions of Research Interns on short duration contract basis (3-6 months) for assisting research work in international affairs including about Latin & Caribbean countries. Persons of Indian nationality or origin holding PIO/OCI cards are eligible.

Research Intern

- Candidates having the following educational qualifications & experience may apply:
- A consistently good academic record (with 60% or more in Social Sciences).
- M.A / M. Phil from a recognized university, preferably in IR/Pol. Sci.
- The initial contractual term of Research Internship in the Council will be of 3 to 6 months. The monthly emoluments will be a lump sum of Rs. 10,000/- only in case of postgraduate & Rs. 12,500/- only for M. Phil level interns.
- No other allowances / facilities will be admissible, except TA/DA for official tours at the rates admissible to Group-B Officers of the Central Government.

Successful candidates must have foreign Language fluency (oral and written) in their area of concentration. ICWA urgently needs fluency in Spain and/or Portuguese for research programmes on LAC countries.

Selected Research Interns will be required to also help organize & participate in conferences, lectures seminars & other academic events organized by the ICWA.
