Vacancy for Research Fellows

The Indian Council of World Affairs (ICWA), an institution of national importance, incorporated under the ICWA Act, 2001, invites applications (in the attached form) for the positions of Research Fellows on contract basis for research work in international affairs. Persons of Indian origin holding PIO/OCI cards are eligible.

Research Fellows: Candidates having the following educational qualifications & experience may apply:

- A consistently good academic record (with 60% or more in Social Science) with a first class masters degree in the field of international relations/political science;
- Ph. D. from a recognized university;
- A strong analytical background with a minimum of 7 years experience in teaching/research work in international relations including M.Phil and Ph.D students.
- At least one published work of repute.

The contractual term of Research Fellows in the Council will be of two years, with a probation period of six months. The monthly emoluments will be a lump sum of Rs. 48,500/- only.

No other allowances facilities will be admissible, except TA/DA for official tours at the rates admissible to Group-A Officers of the Central Government.

Successful candidates must have area specialisations on at least one out of the following areas:- LAC countries, South Asia, PR China, East Asia, ASEAN, North Africa, Iran, GCC countries, EU, USA, International economy and multilateral trade, non-traditional security and global common issues. Applicants with relevant foreign language fluency (oral and written) will be given preference.

Successful Research Fellows will be required to also help organize & participate in conferences/lecture organized by the ICWA.

Interested candidates may apply in sealed cover latest by 12th August 2011, along with detailed bio-data and copies of certificates, to Director, Indian Council of World Affairs, Sapru House, Barakhamba Road, New Delhi-110001. Only short listed candidates will be called for interview.
