While the existing rules of membership of the ICWA Library will continue to be in force, it has now been decided that the books, journals, periodicals and manuscripts available in the ICWA Library will be available for access and study on a **non-borrowing** basis for students/researchers of Indian universities and high schools subject to show of valid identity cards issued by their respective institutions.

This facility would also be available to:

- a) Representatives of Indian Think Tanks with valid identification documents issued by their respective organizations,
- b) Media personnel based on their PIB registration cards, and
- c) Members of foreign diplomatic missions based in Delhi with identity cards issued by the Ministry of External Affairs.

No personal books/reading materials would be allowed into the Library.

Arrangements for safekeeping of personal belongings in separate lockers will be available. Users can contact the reception desk at the library for this purpose.

Xerox facility will be available for users at a nominal fee of Rs. One per page .
