The 19th Sapru House Lecture was delivered by H.E. Mr. James Alix Michel, President of the Republic of Seychelles, on the subject of “Maritime Security for the Blue Economy”, at 1100 hrs on 27 August 2015 in the Sapru House Auditorium, Barakhmaba Road, New Delhi.
