



Vacancy for Research Fellows

The Indian Council of World Affairs (ICWA), declared an institution of national importance by an act of parliament in 2001 incorporated under the ICWA Act, 2001, invites applications ([in the attached form](#)) for positions of **four** Research Fellows on contract basis.

There are vacancies in the areas of 1. *International Terrorism, Radicalization and related issues*; 2. *International/Multilateral Economic Issues* ; 3. *Energy and Climate Change*; and 4. *South Asia*: However scholars of international affairs, strategic analysis and diplomatic history are also encouraged to apply.

Relevant foreign language fluency, as applicable, in the area of specialization is essential.

Research Fellows

Candidates having the following educational qualifications & experience may apply:-

- a) A consistently good academic record (with 60% or more) with a first class Masters degree in the field of international relations/political science/humanities/social sciences;
- b) Ph. D. from a UGC recognized university;
- c) A strong analytical background with post-doctoral experience in teaching/research work in international relations.
- d) List of published works in journals/magazines of repute.

Knowledge of Hindi is desirable.

The contractual term of Research Fellows in the Council will be of two years, with a probation period of six months. The monthly emoluments will be Rs. 66,250/- p.m. (TDS to be deducted as applicable). The candidates are required to submit No Objection Certificate (NOC) from their current employer, if any, at the time of interview. No other allowances/facilities will be admissible, except TA/DA for official tours at the rates admissible to Group-A Officers of the Central Government.

Selected Research Fellows will be required to undertake research in areas to be determined by the Council. They are also required to organize & participate in conferences, lectures & events organized by the ICWA.

Interested candidates may apply in sealed cover by **1700 hrs, 25th January, 2019**, along with detailed bio-data and copies of certificates to **Deputy Director General, Indian Council of World Affairs, Sapru House, Barakhamba Road, New Delhi-110001**. Outstation candidates called for interview will be paid 2nd AC return train fare only, subject to the production of original ticket.
