Vacancy for Director (Research)

The Indian Council of World Affairs (ICWA), an institution of national importance, incorporated under the ICWA Act, 2001, invites applications (in the [attached form](#)) for the position of Director (Research), on contract basis, for conducting ICWA research on international affairs. The successful applicant will be required to plan & supervise the Research Programme of ICWA & be responsible for the research output of the ICWA Research Fellows & faculty. Successful applicant will be required to also help organize & participate in conferences/lecture organized by the ICWA.

Director (Research)

Must be an eminent Indian academic with published books of high quality and articles in national and international journals. Active engagement in research with minimum ten years of experience in guiding doctoral / post-doctoral research or leading research clusters at the University / National level institutions is essential. Applicants should submit a 150-word summary on each of the research projects guided / supervised so far.

Candidates having the following educational qualifications & experience may apply:

- a) A first class academic record in the field of international relations / political science;
- b) Ph.D. in International Relations/ Social Sciences from a recognized university;
- c) A strong analytical background with a minimum of 10 years experience in teaching / research work in international relations; at least two published works.

The contractual term of Director (Research) in the Council will be of two years. There will be no benefits other than those agreed to in the contract. Emoluments of pensioners of Government of India/State Governments/PSUs will be adjusted according to rules.

No other allowances/facilities will be admissible, except TA/DA for official tours at the rates admissible to Group-A Officers of the Central Government.

Preference will be given to academics specialising on Asia. Familiarity with Indian foreign policy. Non-traditional Security & Global Common issues, multilateral affairs, international economic issues etc. will be an advantage. Fluency in language/s of the areas of specialization will be useful.

Only candidates short listed for interview will be informed.

Applications in sealed covers along with detailed bio-data and copies of certificates, made to Deputy Director General, Indian Council of World Affairs, Sapru House, Barakhamba Road, New Delhi-110001 must be delivered to addressee by 12th August 2013.
