The Indian Council of World Affairs (ICWA) is organizing the third pre- India Africa Forum Summit (IAFS-III) conference on ‘India-Africa in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century: Scale and Scope of Comprehensive Partnership’ on 15-16 October 2015.

This pre-IAFS-III conference is an attempt to provide a platform to promote a candid exchange of perspectives and experiences, a comprehensive dialogue on cementing India- Africa partnership, lending it more dynamism, identifying new avenues for collaboration and fostering a greater understanding among multiple stakeholders in India- Africa partnership.

Africa will be represented by the participants from twelve countries of the continent, engaged in profession like academics, think-tanks, government bodies and media. From India, scholars and experts on Africa affairs will participate in the discussion. The two sides will discuss and debate on issues and concerns relating to India-Africa engagement, which has gained pace across diverse fields in various sectors.

The Conference will focus on six important areas that merit special attention under the overall umbrella of India-Africa partnership for mutual growth and development. The themes are: (i) Political relations; (ii) Economic engagement; (iii) Peace and Security Challenges; (iv) Development Cooperation; (v) Media, Culture and Diasporic Linkages; and (vi) Multilateral Engagement.
