The Indian Council of World Affairs (ICWA), in partnership with the Embassy of the Canada in New Delhi, is organizing a Round Table Discussion on the topic, “Canada’s Worldview and Relations with India” on 27 June 2014 at Sapru House, New Delhi. The discussion will be chaired by Ambassador P.K. Budhwar, former High Commissioner of India in Canada. H.E. Mr. Stewart Beck, High Commissioner of Canada in New Delhi will give the keynote address. The panel of the Round Table Discussion comprises of Prof Christopher S. Raj, professor of Canadian studies at the School of International Relations, Jawaharlala Nehru University and Ambassador R.L. Narayan, Former Indian High Commissioner to Canada.

The discussion is being organised with the aim to understand the current trajectory of Indo-Canadian ties. The two countries are brought together by their imperial history and today, remained connected via the commonwealth. The purpose of this discussion is to help foster a deeper understanding for both, thus build stronger relations for the future.
