During the recent visit of the Prime Minister of India to Indonesia, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on cooperation between the Indian Council of World Affairs (ICWA) and the Indonesian Council on World Affairs (ICWA) were signed in Jakarta on 11 October 2013. The MoU was signed by Ambassador Rajiv K. Bhatia, Director General, ICWA, New Delhi and Mr. Ibrahim Yusuf, Chairman of the Executive Board of ICWA, Jakarta.

2. The signing of the MoU was witnessed by Shri Salman Khurshid, Minister of External Affairs and H.E. Marty Natalegawa, the Indonesian Foreign Minister.
3. The MoU aims to enhance mutual understanding and friendship between the two institutions through the promotion of friendly, cooperative and collaborative relations between them. It would enable them to promote the exchange of visits by eminent persons in the fields of diplomacy, culture, economy, trade, education and related areas. The two institutions plan to hold regular dialogue on international, regional, and bilateral issues of mutual interest.
